CONCEPT:

20 designs will be chosen from all entries received. These will undergo an "interview" process with the Leon at CCXIX and St Leger & Viney team. Thereafter, 12 chair designs will be chosen to be manufactured by Leon at CCXIX to be part of an exhibition to be hosted at the Leon at CCXIX showroom at 219 Albert Road, Woodstock. The 12 finalists will also have access to fabric supplied by St Leger & Viney to a maximum value of R5 000, should their design require it. The winning design, including runner up and third placed winner, will be announced at an event at the Leon at CCXIX showroom in September (date TBC).

WHEN DOES THE COMPETITION START AND END?

The competition starts on Monday 10th April 2017 at 09h00 and closes on Friday 16th June 2017 at 17h00. This is the competition period. Leon at CCXIX and St Leger & Viney reserve the right to extend the duration of the competition, subject to these terms and conditions. The winner will be announced at an event hosted by Leon at CCXIX and St Leger & Viney in September 2017.

WHO MAY ENTER THE COMPETITION?

All persons, including South African Citizens and Foreign Nationals, may enter the competition. Any design student and/or professional designer from anywhere in South Africa may enter. 2. A contemporary design.
3. May be an armchair, dining chair, occasional chair or bar stool.
4. The designs must be implementable using the following materials: fabric, timber, metal, woven elements, fibre-glass, wool, leather and hides.

Entrants are asked to submit ONE entry per person.

PRIZES

The winning design will win a design contract with Leon at CCXIX as well as their share of all sales of these designs selected by Leon at CCXIX to go into production. This contract will be valid for a duration of 12 months and renewable, if mutually agreed by both parties, thereafter.

The winning designer will also win R10 000's worth of St Leger & Viney fabric (limited to their local ranges), with the second placed winner receiving R5 000 and third placed winner R2 500's worth of fabric (again, limited to their local ranges).

WINNERS ANNOUNCEMENT:

The winning design, and 2nd and 3rd placed winning designs, will be announced at an event hosted by Leon at CCXIX and St Leger & Viney at the Leon at CCXIX showroom in September (further details will be supplied closer to the time).
